DESCRIPTION

This plot of Everett's First Addition to the Town of Concrete embraces that portion of the west $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, Twp. 35 N., Range 8 E. W.M., more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the centre of Sec. 11 Twp. 35 N., Range 8 E. W.M., thence S $52^{\circ}27'00''$ E. along the north and south centre line of Sec. 11, a distance of 273.69 ft. thence N $50^{\circ}50'00''$ W. along the east boundary line of the Great Northern R.R. Right of Way, a distance of 1265.64 ft. thence N $8^{\circ}52'00''$ E. a distance of 62.15 ft. thence S $61^{\circ}26'00''$ E. a distance of 1029.61 ft. thence S $52^{\circ}27'00''$ E. a distance of 66.21 ft. to the point of beginning.

The initial point of this plot is the centre of Sec. 11, Twp. 35 N., Range 8 E. W.M. The sizes of lots, streets and alleys are as shown on the annexed plot in feet and decimals.


