# MOUNTAIN VIEW ADDITION TO HAMILTON

This Mountain View Addition to Hamilton embraces all the following described tract of land, lying and being in the County of Shagit, State of Washington described as follows to wit: Beginning at the Quarter Section Corner in the east boundary of Section fifteen (15) Township Thirty-five (35) North, Range Six (6) East of Willamette Meridian, running thence West on and along the center line of said Section fifteen (15), the same being on and along the North boundary of Lot one (1) in said Section fifteen (15), nine hundred ninety eight & three tenths (998.3) feet, thence Southerly thirteen hundred thirty four and six tenths feet. (1334.6) to the south boundary of Lot One (1) in said Section fifteen (15), thence east on along the south boundary line of said Lot One (1) in said section fifteen (15) two hundred and fifteen (215) feet to the bank of the Shagit River, thence in a northerly and easterly direction up said river along the north and west bank thereof to the east boundary of said Section fifteen (15) thence North on and along said east boundary of said Section fifteen (15) four hundred fifty three feet (453) to the point of beginning containing twenty-one (21) acres more or less.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: - That we Noah F. McNaught & Mary S. McNaught, his wife, both of Anacortes, State of Washington, owners in fee simple of the above described tract of land, do hereby declare this the plat of Mountain View Addition to Hamilton, and do hereby dedicate to the uses of the Public forever, all the streets, all the street and avenues as herein platted.
