Strategic Planning Goals for the next year(s) include:

____The Town of Concrete will install new historic signage at the Silos (funded in part by the 2019 and 2020 Skagit County Lodging Tax Grants.)

We will partner with the Upper Skagit Library to provide outdoor activity space on the Museum grounds when they complete their move to the new building. The Museum will provide parking and mobilization space for the Library contractors.

____Volunteers continue renovation of the Annex, with drop ceiling and lighting. Museum display items have been moved from storage to create new exhibits, including "This Boy's Life" memorabilia.
