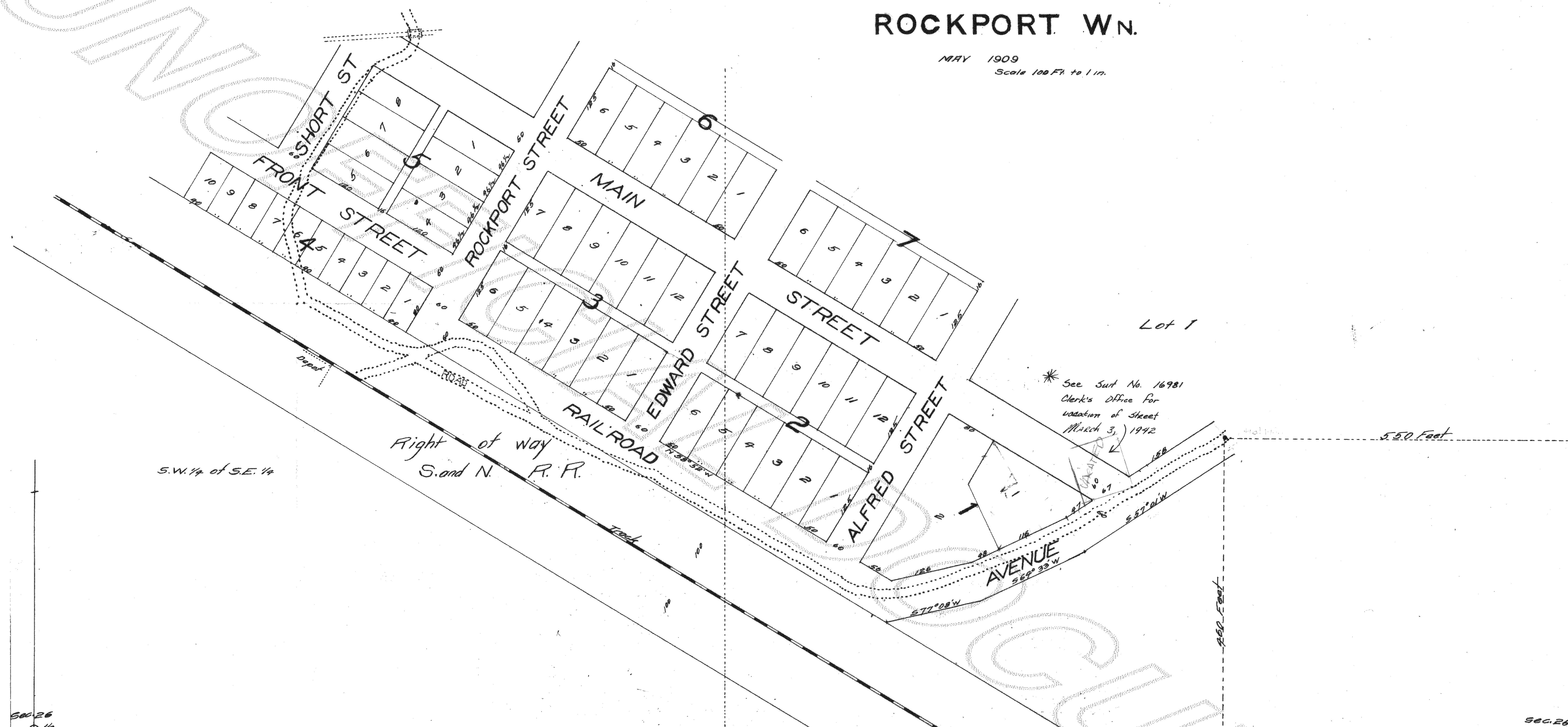


# ROCKPORT W.N.

Scale 100 Ft. to 1 in.



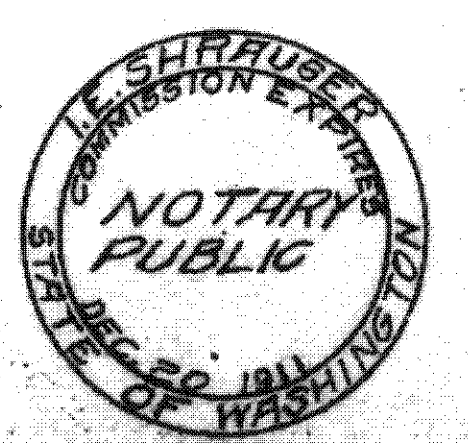
The plat of the town of Rockport, embraces a portion of Lot one (1), and the Southwest Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of the South East Quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section Twenty-Six (26), Township Thirty-Five (35) North of Range Nine (9), East W.M. The initial point is in the center of the County Road No. 99, known as the Huffy Road, and 550 feet west of the Section Line, between Sections 25 and 26, and 160 feet North of the Section Line between Sections 26 and 35, all in Township 35 North of Range 9 East W.M. Skagit County, Washington. The dimensions and sizes of lots and streets are as shown in plat filed herewith.

Know all men by these presents: That we, Alfred Johnson and Betty Johnson, his wife, and Edward Janson and Edw. Janson, his wife, owners in fee simple of the land described in the within plat, hereby declare this plat and dedicate the same to the use of the public forever, all streets, avenues, and alleys, as shown thereon.
